

# EASY MOVING GUIDE

## UPDATE YOUR ADDRESS WITH SOME OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Qld Transport (Car Registration & Drivers License)
- Banks – (Credit cards, bank accounts etc)
- Insurance (House, Contents, Car)
- Solicitors, Accountant, Superannuation
- Your employer
- Electoral Roll
- Library
- Medical (Dentists/Doctors etc)
- Mobile Phone, Home Phone, Internet
- Magazine or newspaper subscriptions
- Australia Post – Mail Redirection service
- Vet (and National Pet Register)

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## SELECT A REMOVALIST COMPANY

Obtain at least 2 quotes and remember to discuss the removal companies insurance.

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## INSURANCE

Arrange contents and household insurance for your new home.

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## NOTIFY SCHOOLS/ENROLMENTS

If you have young children, remember to arrange enrolments and/or notification of change of address, and speak to childcare and daycare centres if required.

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## UTILITIES

Advise your gas, electricity, water & cable TV providers prior to moving to arrange final meter readings and the disconnection & reconnection of each service and arrange to have them connected at your new property. Alternatively we can introduce you to 'Move Me In'. Through their website you can have everything connected in minutes. As part of the service they will also throw in two pizzas and a garlic bread on the day you move in. Speak to us if you'd like to find out more.

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## PACKING

Boxes, wrapping paper and bubblewrap can all be purchased from Kennards Storage and some moving companies e.g Mini Movers. Some can even drop what you need to your home. 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## VACATE & MOVE IN DATES

Confirm your vacate date for your current property and the move in date to your new property. Remember, on occasion, these dates may vary particularly if you have purchased a new property, as sometimes settlement dates can change.

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## CLEANING

Book a cleaner. If you need a little extra help once all of your furniture and belongings are out, a professional cleaner can be a huge help. 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## GARDENING
